Before signing please read the following church requirements for godparents. In accordance with the laws of the Roman Catholic Church (Canons 872,874,892,893) to be a godparent a person *must*:

- Be a person suitable for this role, selected by the candidate's family, and having the intention of fulfilling this role.
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Have received the sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation.
- Be neither the father nor the mother of the person to be baptized.

The godparent's role, together with the parents, is to present the child for Baptism and to help him/her to live a Christian life within the Catholic Church, faithfully fulfilling the duties inherent in Baptism.
