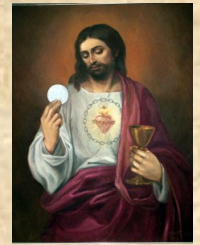

The Scrutinies

This weekend at the 9:AM Sunday Mass, we celebrate the First Scrutiny for the adults in our catechumenal process. We are blessed to have six adults and children who are in their final preparation for initiation at The Easter Vigil. (The children celebrate their scrutiny rites separately).

As early as the second century, Christian communities would help those who had been chosen for Baptism to prepare for their initiation by laying on hands and reciting prayers for protection and deliverance from evil.

Today we continue to celebrate these powerful rituals. The Elect, who are about to enter into a covenant with God, are in need of our prayers. These prayers and intercessions are not limited to just those seeking baptism, but are available to all of the faithful. Our candidate who comes from a Protestant background, is seeking full communion with the church, and also is asking for our support.

In the Gospel reading for the First Scrutiny we hear about *‘The Woman at the Well’* and living water. This living water that we receive at Baptism calls for us to go forth, like the woman, and evangelize to our friends and neighbors. We are called to recognize the need we all share to be freed from all evil and its effects.

For what is it we thirst? That is the question that our Elect and candidates will answer when the First Scrutiny is celebrated.

We invite the entire community of St. Peter & St. Paul to join in us in spirit, as the Elect turn to Christ for freedom from sin and protection from all evil.

SEVEN DEADLY SINS, SEVEN LIVELY VIRTUES



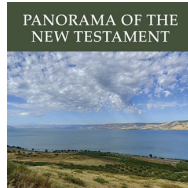
All adults and confirmed teens are invited to join us as we look at the seven deadly sins that are patterns of dysfunction that lead us to unhappiness.

Bishop Barron explains the pervasiveness of sins and how to counteract these sinful patterns through a conscious focus on a specific virtue for each sin.

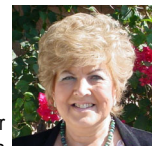

PANORAMA OF THE NEW TESTAMENT SCRIPTURE STUDY Sept. 2017 - May 2018



The world of the New Testament is so far removed from our modern world that it is sometimes difficult to understand what we hear in the Sunday readings or read in Scripture and how it relates to God's message of salvation for our world today. Our scripture study this year is titled, **‘Panorama of the New Testament’**, a study which will reveal the continued plan of salvation as it unfolded among the first generations of Christians from the missionary preaching of St. Paul and the Gospel stories of Jesus through the persecution of the early Christians as encoded in the book of Revelation and God's promise of a "New Heaven and a New Earth." This overview is beneficial both for newcomers to scripture study, as well as those who have already studied much of the New Testament. Our study meets on Monday evenings, beginning on Sept. 18, from 7:00 – 8:30 pm on the first floor of the John Paul II building and is repeated on Thursday mornings which began on Sept 21, in our Parish Library. Explain the different types of "Holy Oils"

There are three types of Holy Oils. "The Oil of Catechumens", "The Oil of the Sick", and "Chrism". The first two are blessed and the third is consecrated by the Bishop at the Mass of Chrism on Holy Thursday morning in the Cathedral Church. In our Diocese, the Cathedral Church is Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral located in San Bernardino. The Oil of Catechumens is used at the Easter Vigil Liturgy for adult converts and also in all Baptismal Liturgies. The Oil of the Sick is used for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Chrism is used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Orders, and other consecrations such as the dedication of a new Altar.
