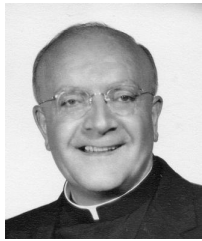

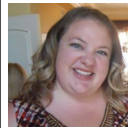

**PANORAMA OF THE NEW TESTAMENT
SCRIPTURE STUDY Sept., 2017 - May, 2018**



The world of the New Testament is so far removed from our modern world that it is sometimes difficult to understand what we hear in the Sunday readings or read in Scripture and how it relates to God's message of salvation for our world today. Our scripture study this year is titled, "Panorama of the New Testament", a study which will reveal the continued plan of salvation as it unfolded among the first generations of Christians from the missionary preaching of St. Paul and the Gospel stories of Jesus through the persecution of the early Christians as encoded in the book of Revelation and God's promise of a "New Heaven and a New Earth." This overview is beneficial both for newcomers to scripture study, as well as those who have already studied much of the New Testament.

Our study meets on Monday evenings, beginning on Sept. 18, from 7:00 – 8:30 pm on the first floor of the John Paul II building and is repeated on Thursday mornings which began on Sept 21, in our Parish Library. 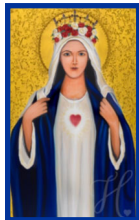

**The Courage to Speak and to
Act Against Abortion**



The mother's womb should be the very safest place for a child. Tragically, it has become the most dangerous location- more dangerous than any battlefield or terrorist target. In some cities, about 40 percent of pregnancies end in abortion.

To defend these innocent children and to speak and act on their behalf takes courage. Perhaps family and friends may not like our pro-life stance. Perhaps we may lose business. We all know people who have had an abortion so perhaps we do not want to offend a relative or loved one. It is all too easy to make excuses or make calculations in our minds and hearts, which often results in paralyzed inaction and apathy.

We are always told of reasons why we cannot speak up against abortion. If the priest speaks in Church, he will be rebuked by some who will try to argue it's too political; if we speak in the political arena, we are told it's too religious. If we speak in the media, we are told it's too disturbing; in our schools and colleges, it's too disruptive. On the public streets, it's too distressing for children; in the business world it's too controversial, in the family it's too divisive, and in social settings, it's too impolite or politically incorrect. So, if abortion is plainly wrong and inhumane (which it most definitely is), how do we do what is right and where do we go to say so? The unambiguous answer is that we must stop looking for a risk-free place to fight abortion, and have the courage to speak up in all these arenas! Let's stop counting the cost to ourselves if we speak up and start counting the cost to the innocent children, if we remain silent.

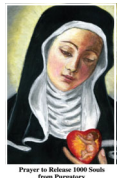

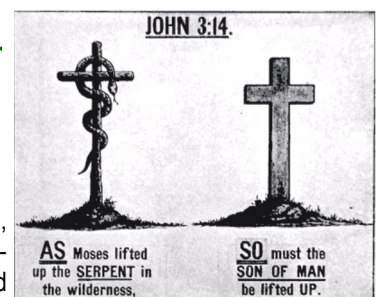

The Catechism of the Catholic Church Paragraph # 128 says: "The Church, as early as apostolic times, and then constantly in her Tradition, has illuminated the unity of the divine plan in the two Testaments through typology, which discerns in God's works of the Old Covenant pre-figurations of what he accomplished in the fullness of time in the person of his incarnate Son". As an old saying put it, the New Testament lies hidden in the Old and the Old Testament is unveiled in the New.
