WHO AM I TO JUDGE?

Responding to **Relativism** with Logic and Love
8 Sessions: April 25 – June 13



What is "right" and "wrong"? Is what's right for you right for me? Is there a right and wrong for everyone, all the time?

These are difficult questions to discuss in our culture. We live in a society that supports the opinion that each person should make up his or her own morality—that there is no moral truth that applies to everyone. Many of us have been affected by the relativistic outlook that pervades the modern world. Maybe some of us wonder whether there really is an absolute right and wrong for everyone. Or maybe we accept that there is a moral standard for all, but we don't know how to explain our moral convictions in a convincing way. Maybe some of us are afraid of saying something is immoral because we're afraid of offending others or of being labeled intolerant. How do we talk about morality in a relativistic world? In this study program featuring Edward Sri, we'll explore the classical view of morality and find that it's not merely a set of guiding principles for theoretical situations—it is an entire way of life. The world of the New Testament is so far removed from our modern world that it is sometimes difficult to understand what we hear in the Sunday readings or read in Scripture and how it relates to God's message of salvation for our world today. Our scripture study this year is titled, "**Panorama of the New Testament**", a study which will reveal the continued plan of salvation as it unfolded among the first generations of Christians from the missionary preaching of St. Paul and the Gospel stories of Jesus through the persecution of the early Christians as encoded in the book of Revelation and God's promise of a "New Heaven and a New Earth." This overview is beneficial both for newcomers to scripture study, as well as those who have already studied much of the New Testament. To defend these innocent children and to speak and act on their behalf takes courage. Perhaps family and friends may not like our pro-life stance. Perhaps we may lose business. We all know people who have had an abortion so perhaps we do not want to offend a relative or loved one. It is all too easy to make excuses or make calculations in our minds and hearts, which often results in paralyzed inaction and apathy.

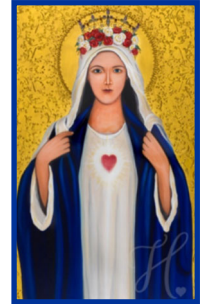
We are always told of reasons why we cannot speak up against abortion. If the priest speaks in Church, he will be rebuked by some who will try to argue it's too political; if we speak in the political arena, we are told it's too religious. If we speak in the media, we are told it's too disturbing; in our schools and colleges, it's too disruptive. On the public streets, it's too distressing for children; in the business world it's too controversial, in the family it's too divisive, and in social settings, it's too impolite or politically incorrect. So, if abortion is plainly wrong and inhumane (which it most definitely is), how do we do what is right and where do we go to say so? The unambiguous answer is that we must stop looking for a risk-free place to fight abortion, and have the courage to speak up in all these arenas! Let's stop counting the cost to ourselves if we speak up and start counting the cost to the innocent children, if we remain silent.

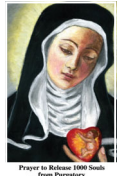

RCIA - A TEACHING MOMENT What is "Sanctifying Grace" ?
