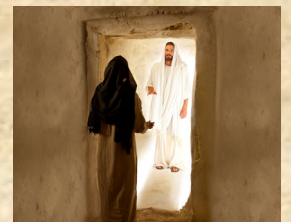

They think He is the promised King, a worldly king of the Jews who will free them from the Roman occupation. It is in faith that we can follow Christ wherever He may lead us, trusting that death is not the end, nor evil the victor.

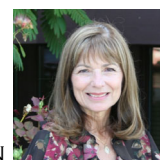

## RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS



The community of St. Peter & St. Paul is blessed to have 6 adults and children who will be received in to the Church at the Easter Vigil on March 31st. Five of them will be receiving the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation & Eucharist and one will be making a profession of faith as well as receiving the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

The Church has been celebrating the various rites with them during the Lenten period of Purification & Enlightenment and this last Tuesday the Elect were formally presented with The Lord's Prayer. The Elect and Candidates will be celebrating the Triduum beginning with the Mass Of The Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday and The Passion Of The Lord on Good Friday, both at 7:00PM. On Holy Saturday, the Elect will prepare for their sacraments with their Preparation Rites. This will take place in the church giving them time to reflect and pray and celebrate one last rite before their baptism. In the Ephphetha rite the Church asks for God to open their eyes and ears so that they may follow Him more willingly with clear vision and understanding. Then at 4PM we will have the lighting of the Easter fire. The holy oils, candle, and palm branches from last year are consumed in this fire. It is from this fire that the new Easter Candle is lit.

The Easter Vigil commences at 7:45 PM in front of the JP II Center with the Blessing of the Fire and Preparation of the Candle.

All are then invited to join us after the Vigil Mass for a reception in the hall. This will give you an opportunity to meet our newest Catholics and offer them your prayers and support. We invite those who may be interested in our Catholic faith to join us on Tuesday evenings.

We meet in the parish library from 7:30PM to 9:30PM. For more information on the process, please call one of the numbers listed in the parish directory.

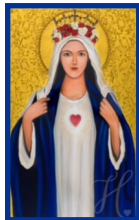

**Personhood**

If you look up the word "person" in your average dictionary, you will find something like this: "Person n. A human being."



When Roe v Wade was decided in 1973, the science of fetology was not able to prove, as it can now, that a living, fully human, and unique individual exists at the moment of fertilization and continues to grow through various stages of development until death.

However, the majority decision in Roe v Wade made a startling admission: "If this suggestion of personhood is established, the appellant's case, of course, collapses, for the fetus' right to life would then be guaranteed specifically by the Amendment." Justice Harry Blackmun, Roe v. Wade . With modern science, it is now straightforward to prove that the unborn child is a human being: "After fertilization has taken place a new human being has come into being. It is no longer a matter of taste or opinion...it is plain experimental evidence. Each individual has a very neat beginning, at conception." Dr. Jerome Lejeune, "Father of Modern Genetics" Within the pro-life movement, there is now an important initiative to include the pre-born as "persons." This terrifies the pro-abortionists because "persons" are protected by a series of God-given rights and constitutional guarantees such as life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

They know that if we clearly define the preborn baby as a "person," they will have the same right to life as all Americans do!
