WHO AM I TO JUDGE?

Responding to **Relativism** with Logic and Love
8 Sessions: April 25 – June 13



What is “right” and “wrong”? Is what’s right for you right for me? Is there a right and wrong for everyone, all the time?

These are difficult questions to discuss in our culture. We live in a society that supports the opinion that each person should make up his or her own morality—that there is no moral truth that applies to everyone. Many of us have been affected by the relativistic outlook that pervades the modern world. Maybe some of us wonder whether there really is an absolute right and wrong for everyone. Or maybe we accept that there is a moral standard for all, but we don’t know how to explain our moral convictions in a convincing way. Maybe some of us are afraid of saying something is immoral because we’re afraid of offending others or of being labeled intolerant. How do we talk about morality in a relativistic world? In this study program featuring Edward Sri, we’ll explore the classical view of morality and find that it’s not merely a set of guiding principles for theoretical situations—it is an entire way of life. **The Courage to Speak and to
Act Against Abortion**

The mother's womb should be the very safest place for a child. Tragically, it has become the most dangerous location- more dangerous than any battlefield or terrorist target. In some cities, about 40 percent of pregnancies end in abortion.



To defend these innocent children and to speak and act on their behalf takes courage. Perhaps family and friends may not like our pro-life stance. Perhaps we may lose business. We all know people who have had an abortion so perhaps we do not want to offend a relative or loved one. It is all too easy to make excuses or make calculations in our minds and hearts, which often results in paralyzed inaction and apathy.

Did you know that a civilly married couple should refrain from receiving Eucharist unless married in the Church? The process by which a civil marriage can be made into a Sacrament is called a Convalidation.

What is a Convalidation?

A convalidation derives from the Latin root meaning “to firm up” or “to strengthen.” To convalidate your civil marriage, it is more than a renewal of vows made previously, but it is a new act of consent essential to marriage. The words that the couple expresses are the outward sign of the gift of self that they exchange. The union then becomes a Marriage Sacrament by which God dispenses graces upon the couple.

“Christ is the source of this grace...Christ dwells with them, gives them the strength to take up their crosses and so follow him, to rise again after they have fallen, to forgive one another, to bear one another’s burdens, to “be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ,” and to love one another with supernatural, tender, and fruitful love. In the joys of their love and family life he gives them here on earth a foretaste of the wedding feast of the Lamb. (CCC 1642)

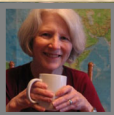

How does the Church define the term "Holy Trinity"?



The mystery of one God in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The revealed truth of the Holy Trinity is at the very root of the Church's living faith as expressed in the Creed. The Son proceeds from the Father while the Holy Spirit proceeds from the father and the Son. Each Person of the Holy Trinity is equally God. In everything they do they act as one. The mystery of the Trinity in itself is inaccessible to the human mind and is the object of faith only because it was revealed by Jesus Christ, the Divine Son of the eternal Father. 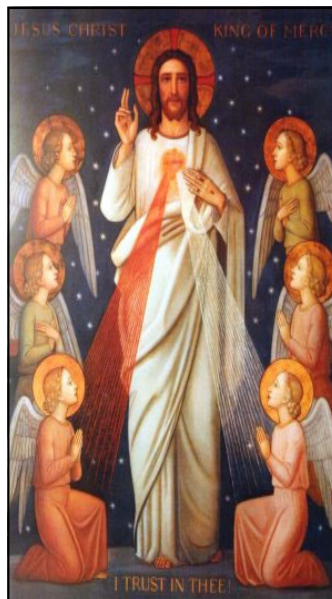

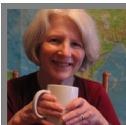
