The Courage to Speak and to Act Against Abortion

The mother's womb should be the very safest place for a child. Tragically, it has become the most dangerous location- more dangerous than any battlefield or terrorist target. In some cities, about 40 percent of pregnancies end in abortion.



To defend these innocent children and to speak and act on their behalf takes courage. Perhaps family and friends may not like our pro-life stance. Perhaps we may lose business. We all know people who have had an abortion so perhaps we do not want to offend a relative or loved one. It is all too easy to make excuses or make calculations in our minds and hearts, which often results in paralyzed inaction and apathy.

Did you know that a civilly married couple should refrain from receiving Eucharist unless married in the Church? The process by which a civil marriage can be made into a Sacrament is called a Convalidation.

What is a Convalidation?

A convalidation derives from the Latin root meaning “to firm up” or “to strengthen.” To convalidate your civil marriage, it is more than a renewal of vows made previously, but it is a new act of consent essential to marriage. The words that the couple expresses are the outward sign of the gift of self that they exchange. The union then becomes a Marriage Sacrament by which God dispenses graces upon the couple.

“Christ is the source of this grace...Christ dwells with them, gives them the strength to take up their crosses and so follow him, to rise again after they have fallen, to forgive one another, to bear one another’s burdens, to “be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ,” and to love one another with supernatural, tender, and fruitful love. In the joys of their love and family life he gives them here on earth a foretaste of the wedding feast of the Lamb. (CCC 1642)

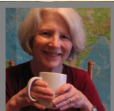



What do the initials I. H. S. and I. N. R. I. stand for?



The letters I. H. S. form a monogram for devotional use of the name of Jesus. It is frequently noted, especially on the vestments of the priest worn at Mass. The letters are popularly taken to mean references to Jesus, Hominum Salvator, Latin words for Jesus, Savior of Men. The letters I. N. R. I. was placed over our Lord's head on the cross. I. N. R. I. the first four letters of the Latin words "Jesus Nazarenus Rex Judaeorum," meaning, "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews."
