**ADULT CONFIRMATION**

To be fully initiated into our Catholic Faith, a person needs to have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. Often, life circumstances may have prevented a baptized Catholic from completing this process at a younger age. As a result, some adult Catholics may have little understanding of our Catholic Faith or its importance in living a Christian life.

Adults 18 years and older who have completed high school are invited to participate in our Adult Confirmation sessions to gain an adult understanding of the basic teachings of our Catholic Faith in order to prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation and living a full, active Catholic life. The sacraments of Reconciliation (Confession) and Eucharist (Communion) will be part of this preparation, where necessary, in order to complete Christian Initiation.

These sessions are always open to any adults who desire an updated understanding of the teachings of our Church, even if there is no need to prepare for sacraments. Our focus is on those serious questions about being Catholic that often come to mind without knowing where to go for answers.

**SCRIPTURE STUDY**

**THE WISDOM LITERATURE of the BIBLE**

In the history of wisdom literature, no tradition matches the solace and depth of the wisdom teachings of the Bible, which offers time-honored advice about some of life's most difficult questions: What is the reward of a virtuous life? How can we best deal with the uncertainty of life? Why does evil exist? Why do bad things happen to good people? How does God show his interest and concern for us?

Wisdom literature has to do with the human person, apart from the Old Testament story of Israel as God's chosen people, even though this literature is part of that larger story and also part of our story as people of the New Covenant with Jesus in the community of the Church. Instead, Wisdom literature addresses the issues that are universal to all humans.

Wisdom shows a "human face" in its concern with human nature and the human condition. Wisdom's strength is universalism, as it looks at all people in their most universal, basic categories of good and evil, of parents and children, of women and men, of peasants and princes, of lazy and diligent. For countless people, these ancient writings have offered consolation and insights into the very meaning of existence. The Wisdom literature of the Bible still has much to teach us today.

The Wisdom books which we will be studying include Proverbs, Job, Ecclesiastes, Sirach, the Song of Songs, and the Wisdom of Solomon, along with several sessions on Jesus as a Wisdom Teacher.

This study will be offered on **Monday evenings from 7:00 – 8:30 pm beginning on Sept. 17, in the St. Augustine room of the John Paul II Center** and is repeated on **Thursday mornings from 9:00 – 10:30 am beginning on Sept. 20 in the Parish Library.** No registration is necessary, just join us at the time most convenient for you.

**Master of Ceremonies Ministry**

The primary role of the Master of Ceremonies (MC) is to assist in organizing the Mass and directing all liturgical movement so it flows with the proper decorum. This is a vibrant, exciting and rewarding ministry. MC's commit to a minimum of one weekend Mass per month and an occasional meeting or weeknight Mass for special celebrations or feast days. MC's are required to have organizational skills, be able to give and take directions and work well with children (Altar Servers).

In our parish the Master of Ceremonies is responsible for the proper and smooth conduct of the various liturgical ceremonies such as the Solemn Mass, Triduum observances etc.

We train on how to prepare the sanctuary and altar, instruct the altar servers in the liturgy, coordinate with the music director, ushers and EMHC and others involved in the liturgy.

The objective is to relieve the celebrant from having to concern himself with the logistics of the ceremony and to allow him to focus on the sacramental aspects of the Mass

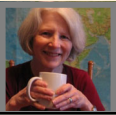

**What is an "Encyclical" ?**

An Encyclical letter is one addressed by the Pope to the Episcopate throughout the world or to the Bishops of a particular country or region. In recent years the popes have more and more given expression on various subjects in this form of communication. Encyclicals are not necessarily infallible documents, but Catholics must accept the doctrinal content. The title of the Encyclical is in Latin, some examples are: **Rerum Novarum** – on the condition of the working classes, **Mystici Corporis Christi** – on the Mystical Body of Christ and **Mater et Magistra** – which dealt with the obligation of wealthy nations to help undeveloped ones. One of the most popular from our Holy Father, Pope Francis it is called **Evangelii Gaudium** – on the proclamation of the Gospel in today's world.

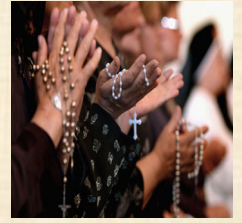

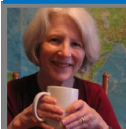
