The Presentation of the Lord, Feb. 2nd
HEART OF MARY WOMEN'S FELLOWSHIP

We invite you and your family to bring candles to be blessed before Holy Mass on **Saturday morning Feb. 2nd at the 7:30AM Mass** as the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This feast occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus. It has also been known as Candlemas day, since there is a blessing and procession of candles at the beginning of Mass. The Presentation of the Lord concludes the celebration of the Nativity and with the offerings of the Virgin Mother and the prophecy of Simeon, the events now point toward Easter. These candles can be your Christ-candle in the center of the dinner table on Sundays and the greater feasts of the year. They can be lighted in days of sorrow, in storms and sickness, or be placed on the family shrine, especially on the family "May-Altar," for evening prayers. If a new member is expected in the family, or if one expects to be chosen for a godparent, a large candle may be brought for the blessing. This candle will then become the symbol of Christ's Light for the Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation, Wedding or Ordination of the child. The same candle can also be used for a Mass of Christian Burial.

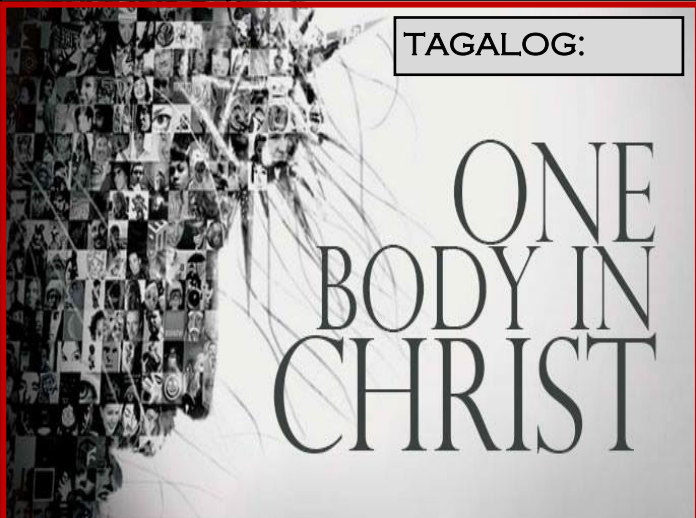
