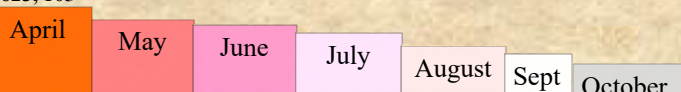

PHISHING SCAMS via TEXT Message or EMAIL

- Fr. Henry nor Fr. Juan is going to send you an email or text asking you to buy a gift card/send money for a sick friend in the hospital.
 - He won't ask you to scratch off the PIN numbers, take a photo and send it to his "friend" in an email.
 - But **someone who has created an email account in your priest's name** might ask you to do so.
 - Much like the "hairless widows with millions to distribute before their rapidly approaching deaths; and that long-lost friend who has lost her luggage and is stuck in London without a passport," **THESE PLEAS and OTHERS LIKE THEM are SCAMS.**
 - We have parishioners who have reported similar stories. The emails are usually sent noting that "the priest is away from the office and can't do this himself."
 - Kind-hearted parishioners anxious to help may not have noticed that the emails, while bearing the correct name or a close-enough version of it, came from an account that the priest does not use.
 - "Step away from the urgency of the email," Andrew Utiger, IT director of the Diocese of Oakland suggests. **Don't click on links or attachments.**
- If you are thinking of going forward, **call the church — at a phone number you know, not one that might be in the email — to verify the request.**
