Lanciano, Italy, 8th Century

A priest has doubts about the Real Presence; however, when he consecrated the Host it transformed into flesh and blood.

This miracle has undergone extensive scientific examination and can only be explained as a miracle. The flesh is actually cardiac tissue which contains arterioles, veins, and nerve fibers.

The blood type as in all other approved Eucharistic miracles is type AB.

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration is the adoration of Jesus Christ Present in the Holy Eucharist. In the many Churches that have this adoration, the Eucharist is displayed in a special holder called monstrance, and people come to pray and worship Jesus continually throughout the day and often the night. Christ’s great love for us was shown when He was crucified on the cross to pay the penalty for our sins and give us eternal life. He loves us without limit, and offers Himself to us in the Holy sacrament of the Eucharist can you not give Jesus a few minutes of love and adoration in return?

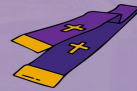

WHAT IS THE SEAL OF CONFESSION?

Given the delicacy and greatness of this ministry and the respect due to persons, the Church declares that every priest who hears confessions is bound under very severe penalties to keep absolute secrecy regarding the sins that his penitents have confessed to him. He can make no use of knowledge that confession gives him about penitents' lives. This secret, which admits of no exceptions, is called the "sacramental seal," because what the penitent has made known to the priest remains "sealed" by the sacrament (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1467).

A confessor who directly violates the sacramental seal, incurs a latae sententiae excommunication reserved to the Apostolic See; he who does so only indirectly is to be punished according to the gravity of the offence (Can. 1388 §1).
