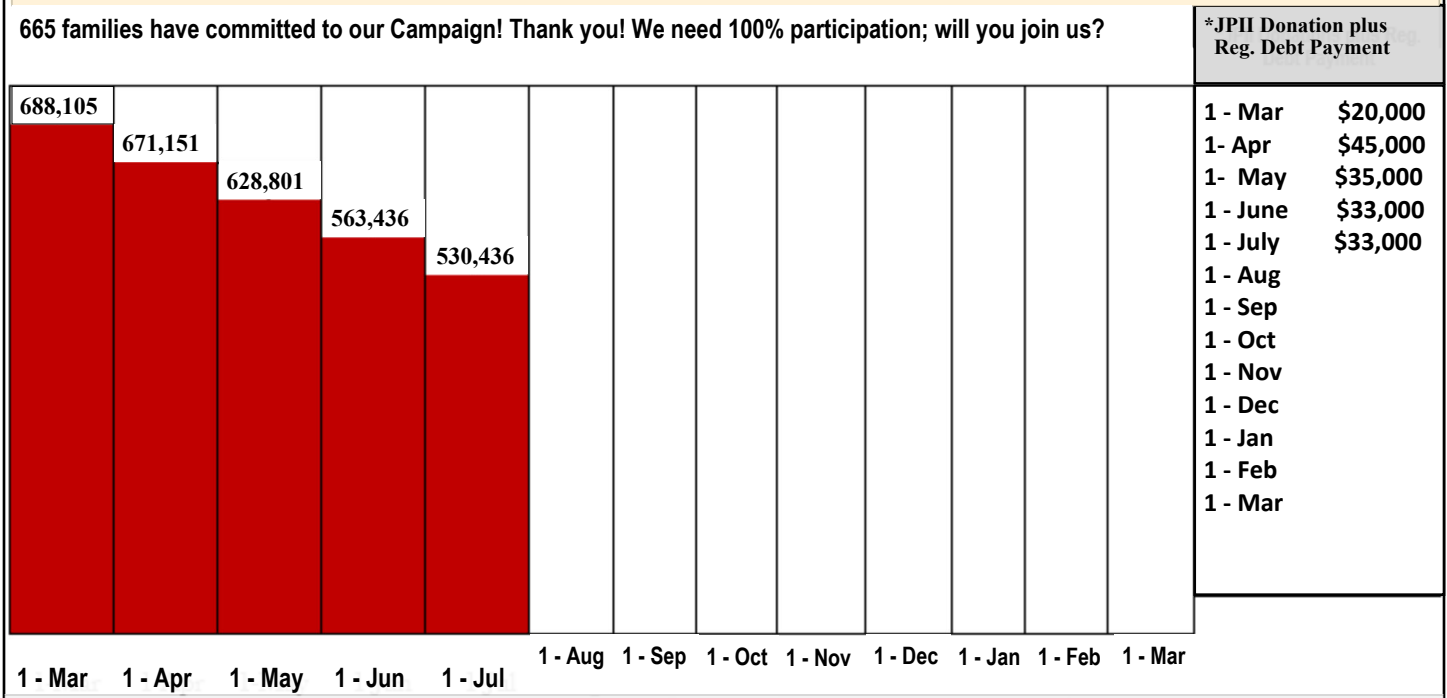

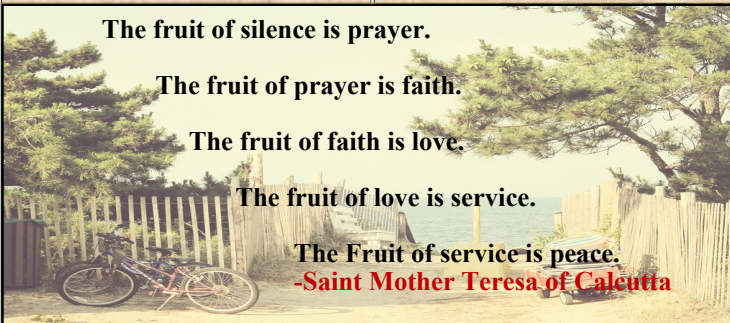

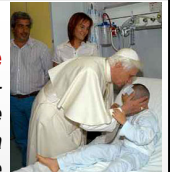
Serving Hands ~ Serving Hearts

Many of them enlisted in the military and fought for America, education was spearheaded by nuns and religious, and Catholic and Protestant evangelicals began to see eye-to-eye on moral issues like abortion and same-sex marriages.
