

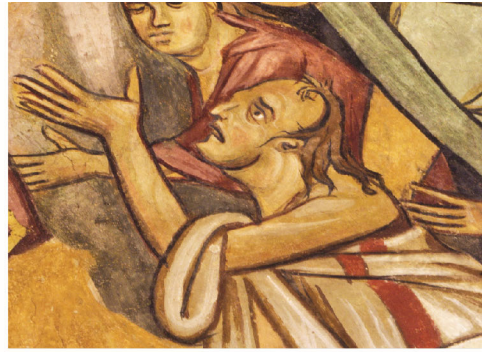

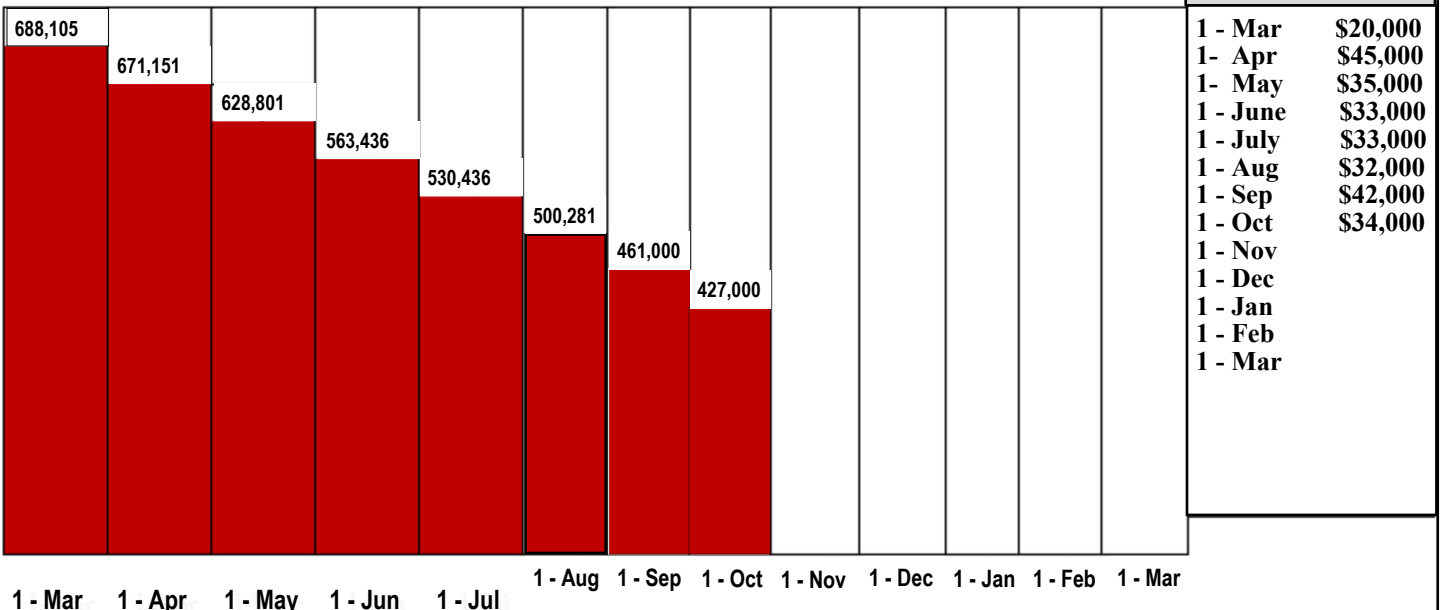

Serving Hands ~ Serving Hearts

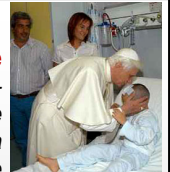
