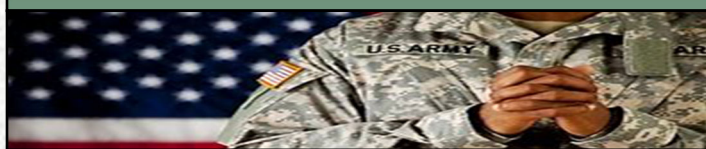

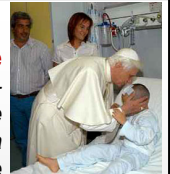
**Serving Hands ~ Serving Hearts**
