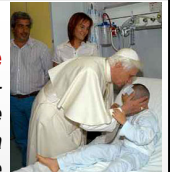
Serving Hands ~ Serving Hearts

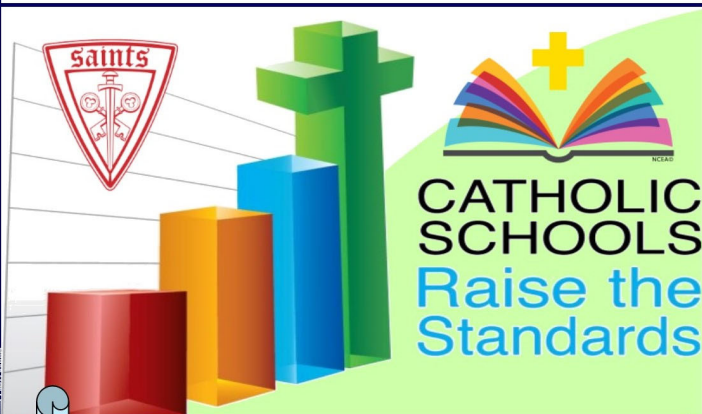

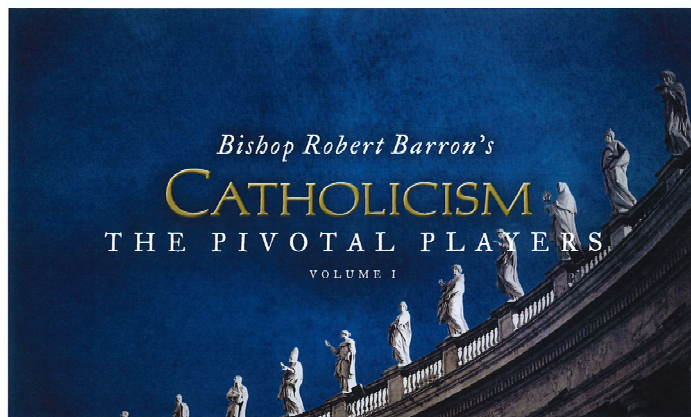

**Women of the Old Testament: Their Lives, Our Hope
 Winter/Spring Scripture Study**
