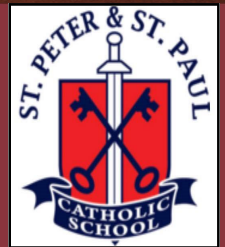

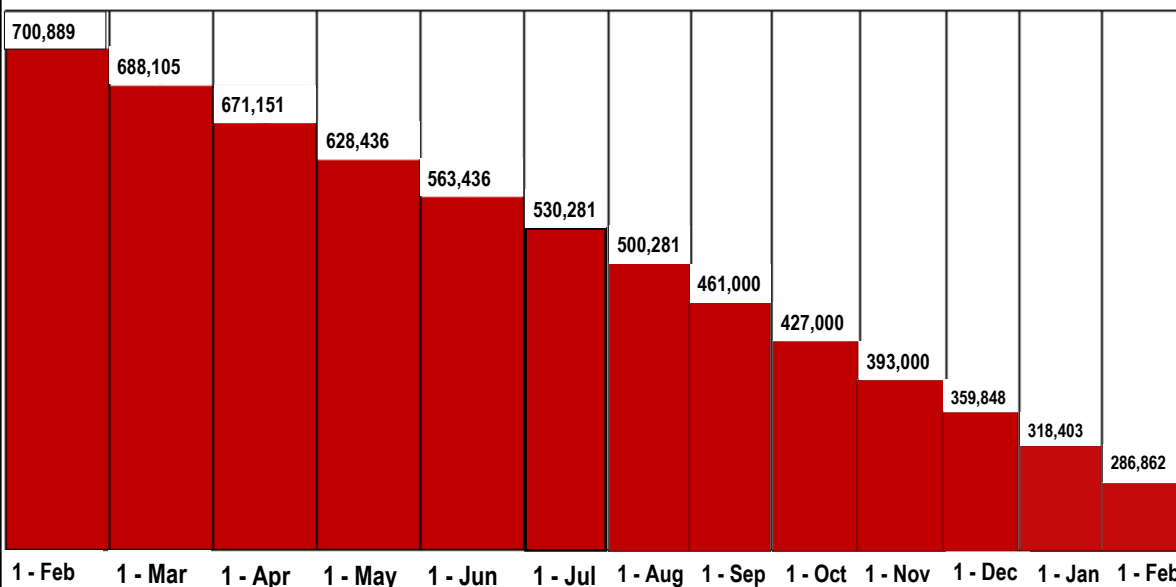



Serving Hands ~ Serving Hearts

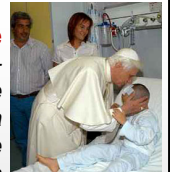

Women of the Old Testament: Their Lives, Our Hope
 Winter/Spring Scripture Study

Although we are probably familiar with the great patriarchs and male figures of the Old Testament, such as Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Moses, and David, there is often a bit of mystery surrounding the lives of the women of these scriptures; yet they also have a role in the history of God's chosen people. Some of the women of the Old Testament often seem obscure to us, with names that we barely remember and lives that are hidden among the more familiar stories.
