We invite the entire community of St. Peter & St. Paul to join in us in spirit, as the Elect turn to Christ for freedom from sin and protection from all evil.

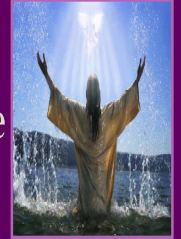
