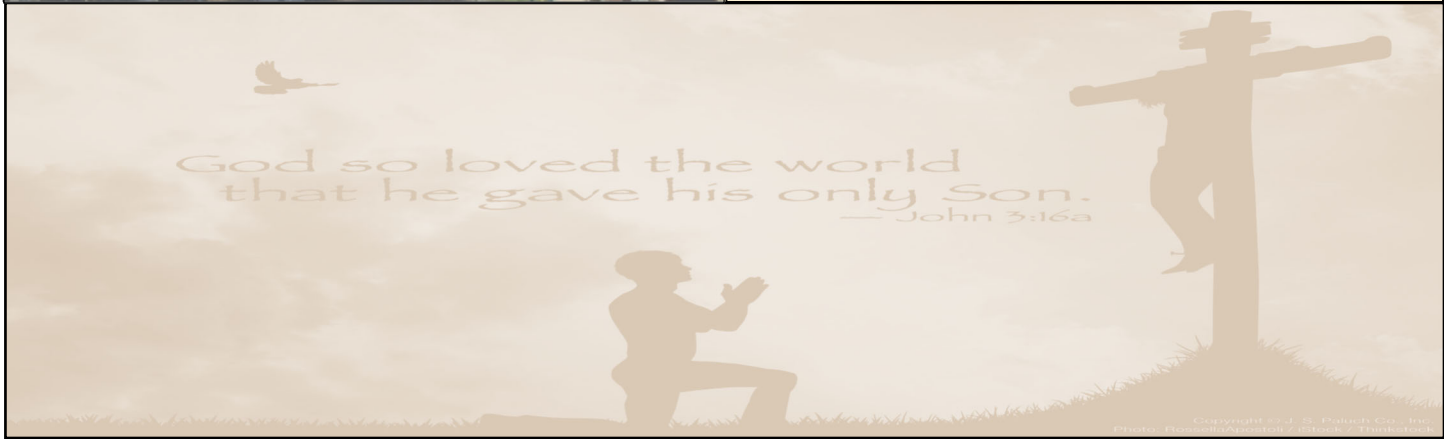

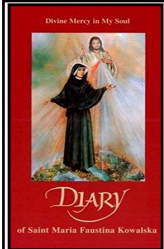
Marriage Moments & Parenting Pointers
