PLEASE NOTE:

- 1) In the event, an employee is required to work on any of the above listed holidays and an alternate day off is not an option, the employee will be paid for the holiday **plus** time and one-half for all hours worked on that day.
- Locations with a Furlough Program: when a Diocesan approved Holiday falls on the scheduled Furlough Day, that day will <u>not</u> be paid as a Holiday; it is an unpaid day.
