## LOVE YOUR ENEMIES

It's likely that some friends or followers of Jesus told him, from time to time, to “get real” when his teachings seemed too hard or impractical. John's Gospel, near the end of the Bread of Life discourse, reports that some disciples out and out turned away because it was too hard to continue following Jesus. When Jesus said to love our enemies, pray for those who hurt us, or do good for those who hate us, the response, “get real,” wouldn't be surprising. And yet, the very life and witness of Jesus is filled with his prophetic examples of doing just that; of refusing to return harm for harm. The lives of the saints are likewise filled with such examples, especially those saints who were laborers in the field for justice and peace. Is this command of Jesus difficult? Yes. Is it impossible? No.

### ROLE REVERSAL

It could have come straight out of a Hollywood script: two enemies, former friends and admirers of each other now pitted against each other. So it is today with Saul and David. Saul had actually praised David for slaying Goliath, and rewarded him by placing him in charge of Israel's military force. David flourished, and was praised, admired for how clearly the hand of God was upon him. Of course, Saul became jealous, and soon hatched a plot to finish him off. In a turning of the tables, Saul actually becomes the vulnerable one, and David has more than one opportunity to kill him. But it is not a surprise ambush that keeps David from slaying Saul, but the realization that Saul is a meshiach (Messiah), God's anointed one, the first to bear this title in Israel. Twice David has an opportunity—the second time he even has a witness and accomplice—and yet he will not do what it seems like the script says he should.

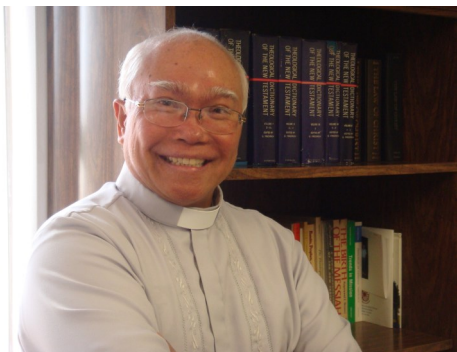
### REWRITE!

Jesus is also a master of subverting our expectations of what the script is going to do. The scriptwriter we call Luke is even more detailed than Matthew in what “love your enemies” means. Luke spells out specific, active ways to counteract the deeds of those whom we would label “enemies.” Beyond that, Luke's Jesus says not to lend merely the shirt off our back, but our coat as well; to lend money not only to those who can repay, but to those who can't. This is the script of God's Meshiach: do not perpetuate or escalate violence, but reply to it with love. What you think is sufficient generosity needs to be doubled, at the very least. Whenever it seems like the direction of the story needs to be changed—so that harm or sin or cruelty is overcome by love—change the story. Through God's goodness, we are free to change our story; through God's grace, we have Jesus to show us the way.

## Listen with the heart....

*A commentary on the readings of the 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time*

### **1 Sm 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23**

This is the last encounter between Saul and David. Saul, the representative of the old way of ruling, was always persecuting David, the symbol of a new way of administering the justice of Yahweh. While Saul with his soldiers were looking for David for the kill, David himself found Saul in total isolation, asleep in the dark. David could have killed Saul, but he did not. Instead, he called out to Abner and to his soldiers for their failure to guard Saul, their king. David would not kill Saul, the

Lord's anointed, even though Saul was totally in his hands. Saul recognized David's voice and responded with a confession: "I have done wrong... I have been a fool and have made a great mistake." David entrusted his whole life completely to the Lord. As Saul went his own wrong way, David placed his trust in the Lord and received from Saul his promise and blessing.

### **1 Cor 15:45-49**

Mocking the imagery used by the non-believers in the resurrection in denying the resurrection, Paul advances the argument: the resurrection is possible because of the infinite limitless power of God. And he raises the argument on a higher level using the imagery of "sowing the seeds". The seed needs to die in order to have a new life coming out of it. That is only possible because of the power of God. And the seed, the body, that was sown and died, will now how a new "glorious body" coming out of it, comparable to the glory of the heavenly bodies, each "glory" different from the other. And now Paul's conclusion: what was sown as corruptible, weak, miserable, like the natural body, will resurrect as incorruptible, glorious, powerful like a spiritual body. Thus the resurrection is not a result of a natural process or evolution but a radical work of the power of God! It is an act more advanced than anyone can imagine. It is a qualitative leap towards the divine sphere that carries with it the corporeal and the earthly, much like what transpired to the resurrected body of Jesus. And the highest peak of Paul's argumentation: the historic Adam-Christ event. Adam is the symbol of being alive, animal-life that comes from the earth. Christ – the second Adam – is the Spirit of life that comes from heaven. And so we were born to the image of the earthly one in the first Adam; but we will also inherit the image of the resurrected one from heaven in Christ, the second Adam. This transformation is possible by the radical act of God's powerful love!

### **Lk 6:27-38**

"Love your enemies." This proposal of Jesus, nay, this commandment of Jesus to his disciples is the answer to the search for an alternative society whose basis is absolutely radically different from the kind of society that we now know or are accustomed to. The society commonly known by humanity – by us – is one that is based on "quid pro quo", "I'll pat your back, you'll pat mine", of revenge and vengeful justice as the "lex talionis", of loving as reciprocal and conditional, expecting and wanting something back in return. These are the characteristics of a society that is minimalistic and operating on instincts. It has formalized its instincts through laws and structures created to protect, defend and promote an unequal society, divided into classes and other forms of social, political and cultural stratifications. There is really no grace nor blessings in that. The only instruments Jesus proposes to change this kind of society and to realize a radically new one that is at the deepest aspirations of the human heart – and in the heart of God – are love, the blessings and well-wishes, starting with the enemy, and prayer. An ongoing act of forgiveness – readiness to forgive - understood as ignoring an offense on the condition that the aggressor becomes aware of the evil he causes, and that this aggressor changes and converts not only to repentance but to be in solidarity with the victim, to be with the side of the wronged. The generous sharing of goods as a response to covetous greed. A decisive rejection of avarice and usury (read: profit-accumulation and legalized commissions) as fundamental causes of the enrichment of the few and the impoverishment of the majority. In short: do unto others as we would like others to do unto us!

Indeed, can we love our enemies? Can we, who make ourselves the enemies of others, change and be converted and be on the side of the offended, be in solidarity with our very own victims? 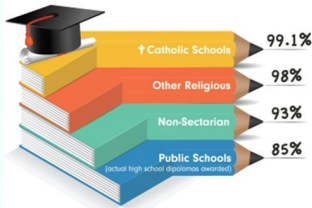

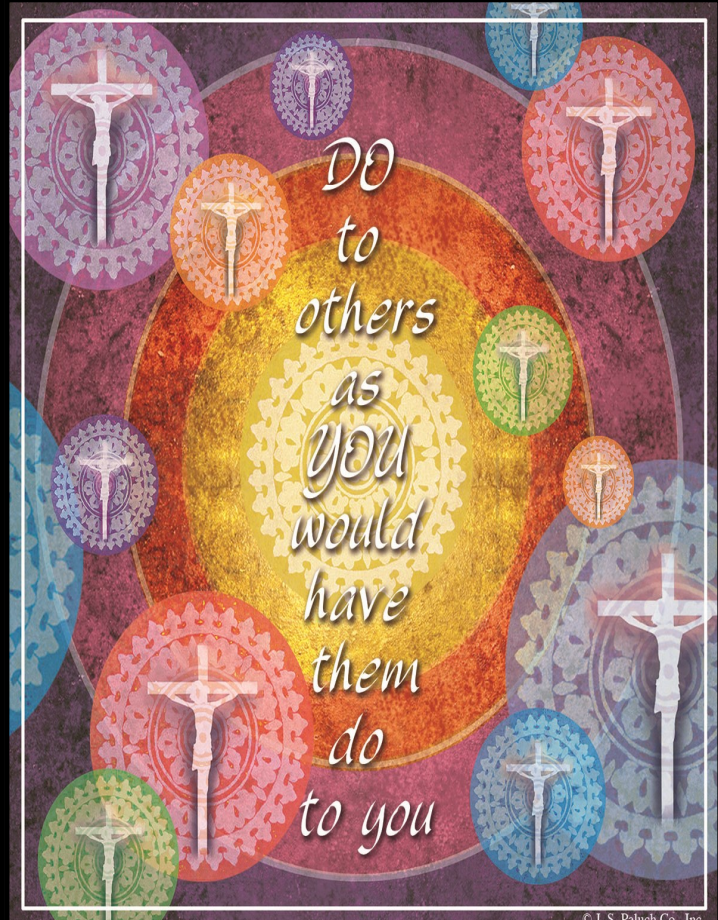
