





We the people of St. Peter and St. Paul Parish, as members of the Roman Catholic Church, are a sacramental, worshiping community on a journey towards the fulfillment of Christ's Kingdom. We strive to provide a spiritual haven for all people without distinction. We are equally committed to the challenges of the gospel message. We accept its call to ongoing conversion, the use of our gifts for the benefit of our community, and loving service to one another.



#### Jesus Christ and his Mission in the Gospels

(Please, read the whole gospel of St. Matthew, slowly and reverently).

#### The Lukan Story:

Luke uses the basic structure of the Markan drama and shares common sources with Matthew. He has his own special Lukan material, however, like the infancy narratives and genealogy in the beginning, and his own post-resurrection stories in the end. But, most significantly, in his Luke-Acts,

he extends the geographical settings from Galilee and the Judaean hills to Jerusalem , and then to Rome , the real imperial power behind Jerusalem . In fact, Jerusalem seems to take a central significance in the mission of Jesus in this Lukan gospel, and Rome as the final destination in the mission of the Christian community in the Acts through the person of Paul.

The decisiveness with which Luke wants us to see Jesus' single-minded resolve to enter Jerusalem is demonstrated by this contrasting description: Jesus set his face to go to Jerusalem , but the people along the way (a village of Samaritans ) would not receive him because his face was set toward Jerusalem (Lk 9:51-53). For Jesus himself, within the context of a conflictivity, has been portrayed earlier as the sign of contradiction: his moment of acceptance is also his moment of rejection (Lk 4:22).

The unfolding of this contradiction can be traced by the Lukan use of "TODAY". This word appears 12 times in Luke's gospel and in truly well-positioned strategic places.

2:11 proclaims the biological birth of the savior TODAY

3:22 announces the claim for the divine birth of Jesus TODAY

4:21 declares the fulfillment of the scriptures in the beginning of Jesus' ministry TODAY

5:26 shows the acceptance of the great ministry of Jesus by the people TODAY

12:28 describes by comparison our human attitude in life relative to the primacy of God's reign TODAY

13:32.33 details the consequences of the ministry in relation to earthly kingdoms TODAY

19:5.9 asserts that salvation is possible for a repentant sinner on earth TODAY

22:34.61 illustrates the possibility of denying Jesus in order to save oneself TODAY

23:43 offers the finality: salvation TODAY is also decisively a future reality

This is the Lukan outline of Salvation History, punctuated by episodes and sayings of resistance by the poor and woes upon the oppressors and ruling cities. It is for this salvation history that Jesus is portrayed to have assembled a group of twelve, sending them to "preach(ing) the gospel and heal (ing) everywhere" (9:6b), "with the power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases" (9:1-2). The urgency and necessity of this Jesus' mission NOW have again been emphasized by the appointment of the seventy or seventy-two others, sent two by two, to prepare for his coming into every chosen village (10,1-12).


It is instructive to note that the gift of salvation and its finality is the mission of Jesus TODAY. We, the Christian community in history, are invited to participate in this mission of salvation of Jesus TODAY, even as its decisive fulfilment is tomorrow. Indeed, the past and the future, as a

continuum, is in TODAY. (to be continued)
