





Can He Do That?

When I accepted the position of Liturgy Director for our parish, I wasn't certain as to what it would involve. I trusted that our pastor and the Holy Spirit knew what they were doing, as it was definitely a leap of faith for me. One thing for sure, I have come to learn a lot about our liturgies and how the Church wants them to be implemented. I receive many questions from people who attend our church or other Catholic churches inquiring about why something *is* or *isn't* done a certain way. They see something done one way in their church and wonder why it isn't done the same way when they visit their Aunt Harriet's church in Des Moines, lowa. They want to know why one priest chants and others don't, or why one wears his stole inside his chasuble and another wears it outside. I never realized that there would be so much 'concern' over the rubrics of the Mass. The faithful really do want to *know* whether their priest is doing things properly or not.

Our priests are very different from a minister or preacher in another faith. They are ordained by the bishop and have a direct link to the Magisterium and The Vatican. This is called Apostolic Succession and it traces their authority all the way back to St. Peter and the apostles, who in turn, were empowered by Jesus Christ. They have three main functions in their ordained ministry...to teach, to govern and to sanctify the faithful. By their ordination, they are able to confect the Eucharist, and no other person has this privilege. A deacon, even though ordained, does not have this charism. Only a priest or bishop has the honor of presiding over the Holy Mass. A deacon or layperson can preside over other liturgies, i.e. a vigil services, a Liturgy of the Word or a baptism, but not a Mass

The Roman Missal is the big red book used at the altar in many Catholic churches. This book is used to guide and instruct the priest in determining the prayers and responses he will use for various Masses. Some of the prayers are fixed and others give several options, but it is strictly the decision of the priest as to which options are used. The General Instructions of the Roman Missal is where all rubrics are found and it is where we go for answers to questions pertaining to the celebration of Holy Mass. The priest is responsible for implementing all of the rubrics and providing the proper form of Mass for the faithful as the Church intended.

The priest is the 'conductor' of the Mass and has the authority to determine who will serve or assist. The deacon, acolyte and all lay ministers are under his charge when serving at the altar. He chooses some of the optional prayers and responses that are offered and decides *how* they will be recited or chanted. He has the option to insert explanatory remarks if he sees the need and he may also guide the faithful in their gestures and movements during the liturgy. When he stands...we stand; when he sits... we sit; when he kneels or genuflects...we kneel or bow. Our priests show us how to be reverent when celebrating Mass and *every* priest gives us Jesus Christ in the Eucharist...and that is *truly* a gift.

Any Catholic Community that has a priest should feel blessed for having one (or even two) in their parish. Unless a priest is teaching heresy or doing something illegal or sacrilegious, he is not in serious violation of any rubric or Church law. He is human and may make mistakes, just like you and I, but the last thing a priest wants to hear from the faithful is that he is doing something improper. However, he *does* need to hear how much he is loved and appreciated. Anytime we feel the need to approach a priest with a specific concern or criticism, it is good to do so with charity, kindness, and respect. After all, they *do* represent Christ here on earth and the sacraments *do* flow from their hands and their lips. They have given their lives for Christ and for us, the Church. They have chosen to forgo marriage and family, and this can make for a very lonely life. It is important that they know and feel that we are their family. Our hearts and prayers should *always* go out to our beloved priests because of the sacrifice that they have made in giving their lives to this blessed vocation.

There is a shortage of priests in our Church, and our bishops are doing everything in their power to contend with this crisis by asking for help from bishops in other countries. Our priests should not have to come from a foreign land. They really should be coming from our own families and the local Church Community.

Our priests are a gift from God and they are a blessing to our Church. If we sometimes forget about the importance of promoting vocations to the priesthood, we should remember that... *they* can have a Mass without *us*, but *we* cannot have a Mass without *them*.




HAVE YOU LOST A LOVED ONE?
