

### **The Common Denominator**

Most family surnames can be traced back for generations. This surname enables us to trace our lineage so we are able to discover who our family members were centuries ago. In our culture, when a woman marries, in most cases, she takes the surname of her husband's family. Her name changes, but her lineage *always* remains the same. If there are problems within a family, and a member decides to 'leave', he/she would still be a member of that family. And, most likely, the parents would always love them and recognize them as part of their family.

The same is true when we trace the lineage of our Catholic Church. All historians agree that our Church, founded by Jesus Christ, is the original Christian Church. All other Christian denominations find their origin in the Catholic Church. At the time of the Reformation in the sixteenth century, many people 'left' the Church, and several Protestant denominations were formed. But, all *came* from the Catholic Church...that is their lineage. They just changed their names, i.e. Martin Luther (Lutherans), Henry VIII (Anglicans/Episcopalians), Ulrich Zwingli (Zwinglism, which is pure Protestant theology), and John Calvin (Calvinism/ Presbyterian and Church of Christ). They were *all* Catholic. In fact, Luther and Zwingli were priests, Calvin was from a prominent Catholic family and of course Henry VIII was King of England. The churches that these 'men' *founded* could not support their theology without the roots of the Catholic Church. All of them were members of our Catholic family, but because of disagreements, they decided to leave. Some, who came afterwards, *still* couldn't agree with the reformers. Many more splintered off and left *those* new churches. But, Mother Church *never* left them and she never wanted her family split and to this day has a desire for unity in the family.

As Catholics, we are different than many of the various Christian denominations. For one, we are not a denomination in the sense of the Christian world, because we did not *evolve* out of a Church; we *are* the Church, from where *all* other Christian Churches have evolved. In other words, the Catholic Church is the 'common denominator' for all who believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and savior of the world. Without the Catholic Church, founded by Christ Himself, there would be no other Christian communities. The bible, as we know it today, evolved out of the Church...not vice versa. The doctrines of the 'Resurrection', the 'Trinity' and the 'Virgin Birth' *all* were formed and developed from the early church fathers, who were guided by the Holy Spirit and answered the many questions that people were asking.

The word 'catholic' means universal. We are a universal Church, where all are welcome and all are recognized as being worthy of salvation. This salvation comes to us from our God, who offered His only begotten Son to die for us. God is our Father, Jesus is our brother, and we are all related by the spilling of His blood. We have been a family for over two thousand years...battered, broken and split. But we *all* still have the same name.... 'Christian'. This name is the 'common denominator' for all who believe.



#### **Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

#### **VOTE NO ON PROP 1**

Prop 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. It is an expensive and misleading ballot measure that allows unlimited late-term abortions – for any reason, at any time, even moments before birth, paid for by tax dollars.

Prop 1 isn't needed. Sadly, California already has some of the most permissive abortion laws in the nation that would remain in effect without the amendment, including our current limit on late-term abortions that are permitted only for the life and health of the mother. Prop 1 destroys this commonsense limit. California does not limit state spending on abortion, and with thousands more traveling from other states, the cost will be in the hundreds of millions. Don't hand lawmakers a blank check to pay for abortions, and don't let them make California an "abortion sanctuary."


