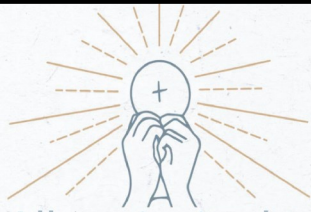

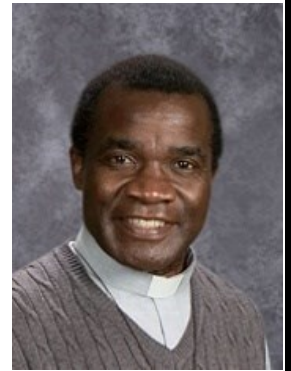

Taking Jesus to the Streets

In two weeks, for the Feast of Corpus Christi on June 2nd, our church will be hosting a special 5:00 PM Mass, followed by a Eucharistic procession through the streets of Alta Loma. We have, for some time, provided our parish community Eucharistic Adoration in the church every Wednesday and Friday thru Saturday morning. This means that our Lord Jesus Christ is exposed in the monstrance on our altar for that entire period of time. The faithful come in at all hours of the day or night to pray, discern and listen to what God has to say to them. You will find people in our chapel at 4:PM and 4:AM, praying or just experiencing God's presence in a quiet contemplative atmosphere. There is no music and no chatter...just silence, and an environment suitable for peaceful reflection.

You might ask how the two devotions, adoration, and Eucharistic processions, are related. Both the late Pope Benedict XVI and John Paul II wrote many letters about the importance of both. Whenever a church has these devotions, it allows the faithful to get closer to Jesus outside of the Sunday celebration. We are encouraged to make 'mini retreats' of anywhere from a few *minutes* to a few *hours*. This enables us to step out of our busy lives and give some of our precious time to the Lord. Pope Benedict told us that, "*Adoration of the Eucharist, together with a procession, calls attention to the fact that Christ sacrificed Himself for all humanity.*" Jesus didn't die and offer salvation to Catholics *only*, or even just 'Christians' for that matter. The kingdom of God is not only for the people who believe in Jesus Christ, but for the entire world and *all* mankind. That is why we call ourselves the Catholic Church. Catholic, meaning 'Universal', or "The Whole" pertains to every living, breathing human being, whether they believe or not. Jesus Christ's act of love was meant for all, not just a select few. No one is left out of the equation, not even someone who is an atheist or non-believer. *All* are welcome, and *all* are offered the same gift of salvation.

Our duty, as Catholics, is to never underestimate the importance of displaying and practicing public acts of religion. We are called to share our faith with anyone who will listen. We are to never hold it in and keep it to ourselves. This is why we are not having our procession only in our church parking lot. We will be taking Jesus out to the streets and allowing the entire neighborhood to be blessed by His presence. We will be displaying our faith, our devotion, and the Word of God as we take Him *out* of our church building and honor Him publicly.

We will have our children, who just recently received their first communion, participate in the Mass and procession. They will be wearing their white garments, leading the way for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Our own Fr. Andres will be presiding at Mass and leading the faithful in our procession. We will stop four times along the way at the homes of parishioners, where an altar will be decorated to receive Jesus with honor and dignity. The Gospel will be proclaimed, and benediction will be given at each home.

In this Eucharistic procession, the faithful believers of St. Peter & St. Paul will publicly acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord and that His love for us is endless. Pope Benedict XVI also said, "*His passing among the houses along the streets of our community will be for those residents an offering of joy, eternal life, peace, and love...we will immerse Him...in the daily routine of our lives, so that He may walk where we walk and live where we live.*"

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the families who will be hosting our stations along the processional route... on Eastwood Ave., the Roldan and McCullough families, on Golden St., the Case family, and on Coca St, the Calma family. We are truly blessed to have them as committed and loving members of our parish community.

I invite *all* our parish family to walk the walk with Jesus and join us in showing Him to the world by 'taking Him to the streets'.

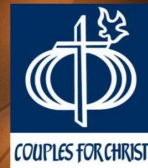

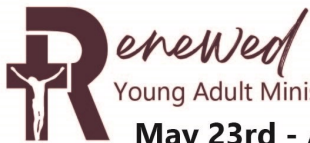


